Before that she served as Music Specialist at the John Marshall Elementary School in Dorchester, MA for 13 years and taught undergraduate music courses at Pine Manor College in Chestnut Hill, MA from 2006 – 2011. Ms. Ambush has been teaching theory classes and directing children's choruses with the Treble Chorus of New England in Andover, MA since 2007.

Ms. Ambush received her Bachelor of Music Education Degree from Howard University in Washington, DC. She was the Neighborhood Site Director with the Boston Children's Chorus at Villa Victoria in the South End from 2004 to 2008. She served as keyboardist for the Christ Temple of Godly Wisdom Ministry in Framingham from 1992-2012.
