The Broadmoor Chamber Singers was founded by Floice Lund in 1979, when a group of music teachers and singers gave a series of concerts dedicated to raising funds for the addition of a solar barn to the Broadmoor Bird Sanctuary in South Natick.

In the following years, this Natick community-based choir has provided concerts in many venues throughout the MetroWest area, including special town gatherings and celebrations, Natick's New England Folk Festival, for social and educational groups, churches, businesses and retirement communities. Further afield, audiences have included Faneuil Hall and The Museum of Fine Arts (Boston), Hammond Castle (Gloucester), and Higgins' Armory (Worcester).

The group is noted for its diverse performances, with special emphasis on unaccompanied choral works from every musical period. The group has also performed extended accompanied works such as Britten's "Ceremony of Carols" and Mozart's "Coronation Mass."
